| Trainees must apply to take the State Water Treatment<br>Operator's certification exam for Grade 1, or higher<br>certification within nine (9) months of appointment to the<br>position. Additionally, Trainees must apply to take the<br>Grade 1, or higher Distribution certification exam within<br>six (6) months of obtaining water Treatment licensure.   |  |
